WHEN: Monday June 26 [back-up date Monday August 7]

WHERE: Chatswood Rotary War Memorial Athletics Field

TRANSPORT: by bus under the supervision of their teacher. The bus will leave school at 9.15am and return by 3.10pm.

WHO: all students K to 6

WHAT: athletic track and field events, and/or novelty event

REGISTRATION: All students in Year 2 [only those who turn 8 in 2023] to Year 6 and wish to compete in the 100m, 200m, 800m or 1500m track events and/or the high jump and long jump field events will need to be to pre-register using the google form at this address: <https://forms.gle/CQCsZZrsmeiTpoJy5> [this link is available in the Principal's message of today's Whaler].

Registration closes at 3pm on Tuesday 13 June.

COST: \$26 and was not included on the Statement of Account sent earlier this year.

PAYMENT: can be made using the following options:

Shot put and discus will be conducted at school with the assistance of the Fit Futures staff.

The 800m and 1500m track events will be held at 9am. Students who wish to participate in these events will need to be transported to the oval by parents/carers.

This year all track events will be run as timed finals.

All students are to wear their sports uniform and must wear a hat when not competing. Students should bring along a small tote bag with a filled drink bottle, sunscreen and lunch.

Students can order a *carnival pack* from our school canteen (choice of 2 pizzas + piece of fruit + packet of chips) which will be delivered to students at the venue. Orders via Flexischools close on Friday at 3.00pm. Students must bring their own drink.

If wet weather prevails, these *carnival packs* will be delivered to classrooms.

A program will be published in the Whaler later in the term with approximate times for each event.
