

Inappropriate Behaviours

Aggressive behaviour = Minor Incident card

Three of the below or similar incidences in the classroom or playground (per term) = Minor Incident card

Including but not limited to:

- Mocking peers – inappropriate comments, name calling etc.
- Unfair play
- Unsafe play
- Playing with sticks
- Teasing
- Being rude
- Being mean
- Swearing (indirect – not at someone)

Disobedient behaviour = Minor Incident card

Including but not limited to:

- Out of bounds
- Not staying in the shade when not wearing a hat
- Littering
- Playing in the toilets/at bubblers
- Unsafe play/unsafe behaviour
- Not lining up correctly at canteen
- Disruptive behaviour (talking, not paying attention)
- Rule breaking
- Climbing trees
- Off task – not working
- Interrupting teaching and learning
- Not following teacher instructions
- Calling out repeatedly/inappropriate noise/s
- Moving around room without permission
- Misuse school property
- Absconding from an adult
- Disregarding the ICT – Responsible Usage Agreement

Aggressive behaviour = Major Incident card

One of the below or similar incidences in the classroom or playground (per semester) = Major Incident card

Including but not limited to:

- Deliberate damage of school property or another student's property
- Insolence to a staff member / adult
- Dangerous play
- Physical aggression
- Bullying
- Racism
- Bad language – swearing - threatening
- Rough play/fighting
- Excluding others repeatedly
- Inappropriate behaviour in/around school
- Verbal and physical confrontation
- Cyber-bullying
- Repeated “put downs”
- Intimidation of others
- Aggression with intent:
 - intimidation/bullying
 - threatening
 - biting
 - punching/ hitting
 - hair pulling
 - scratching
 - slapping/smacking
 - restraining
 - spitting
 - swearing (direct – abusive, directed at someone)
- Having a weapon at school/using an item as a weapon

Disobedient behaviour = Major Incident card

Including but not limited to:

- Stealing
- Repeated defiance
- Leaving classroom without permission
- Defacing school property
- Rudeness/profanity towards staff/students
- Swearing – bad language - non-threatening
- Excessive non-compliance
- Dangerous behaviour
- Refusing to obey instructions
- Continued disobedience
- Vandalism
- Leaving school grounds
- Sharing inappropriate content
- Disregarding the ICT – Responsible Usage Agreement

NB: Following investigation, appropriate action will be taken depending on the severity and nature of the incident. If the incident requires further investigation, complete a YELLOW CARD and write on the front top FURTHER INVESTIGATION REQUIRED and give to the stage supervisor. Tell the child that they will be informed whether the consequence is RED, YELLOW or DISCUSSION ONLY.
